R.Y.A. Practical Courses April 14 - 21, 2012

In April 2012, the Club will again run its popular 7 day R.Y.A. practical courses, commencing and finishing at Largs Yacht Haven in Ayrshire, Scotland. A number of chartered sailing yachts will be skippered by R.Y.A. Instructors from the Club, enabling members and others to take the following courses:

Competent Crew Practical
Day Skipper Practical
Coastal Skipper Practical

The Clyde Estuary is an extremely attractive and relatively well sheltered area for sailing. Its islands, protected anchorages, harbours and marinas help to make it ideal as a training area. Each boat will have a maximum of 4 students on board, in the interests of individual attention and comfort. The cost will be £400 for RNYC members, including on-board meals and harbour dues. (For non-members the cost will be £420, including £20 Temporary Membership fee)
